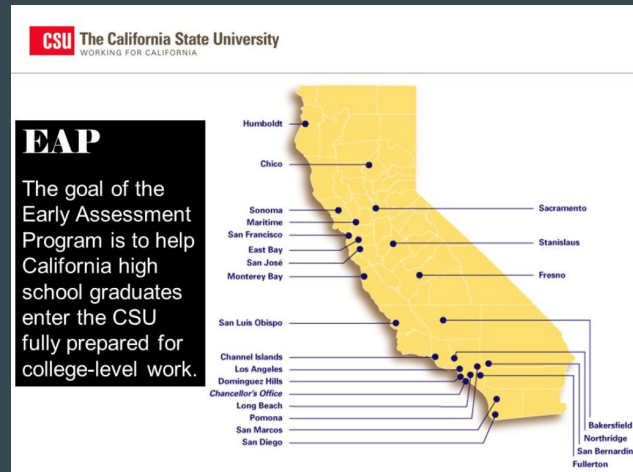

# EARLY ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (EAP)/PROGRAMA DE EVALUACION (EAP)

- SBAC & college readiness
  - based on their performance on the test
- College-level coursework in English and mathematics
  - used by the California State University (CSU) and participating California Community Colleges (CCCs)

# EARLY ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (EAP)/PROGRAMA DE EVALUACION (EAP)

- Results are only used to determine a student's placement after he or she has been admitted to the California State University.
- Students will find their EAP status reported on the front of the 2017–18 Student Score Report. There are four possible EAP status levels:
  - Ready
  - Conditionally Ready
  - Not Yet Ready
  - Not Ready



# CAL GRANT ELIGIBILITY



## TO QUALIFY:

- Submit the FAFSA or Dream Act application and your verified Cal Grant GPA by the deadline
- Be a U.S. citizen or eligible noncitizen or meet AB540 eligibility criteria
- Be a California resident for 1 year
- Attend a qualifying California college
- Have financial need at the college of your choice
- Have family income and assets below the minimum levels

## PARA CALIFICAR:

- Someter la solicitud FAFSA o Dream Act y su Cal Grant GPA verificado antes de la fecha límite.
- Ser ciudadano de EE. UU. o no ciudadano elegible o cumplir con los criterios de elegibilidad AB540
- Ser un residente de California por 1 año asistir a un colegio comunitario calificado de California
- Tener necesidad financiera en la universidad de su elección
- Tener ingresos familiares y activos por debajo de los niveles mínimos

# Graduation vs. A-G

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## GRADUATION

**Social Science 30 Credits:** World History, US History, US Government, Economics

**English 40 Credits:** English 9, English 10, English 11, English 12

**Mathematics 20 Credits:** *Algebra I or higher. Courses below Algebra I do not count toward the 20 credits required for graduation.*

**Science 20 Credits:** Biological Science, Physical Science

**World Languages/Visual and Performing Arts/Practical Arts 20 Credits:** *10 credits in two of three areas.*

**PE 20 credits:** plus Fitnessgram ( Dance or Sport)

**Electives 70 Credits**

## A-G : NO D or F ACCEPTED

**A. Social Science 2 years required:** World History, US History, US Government, Economics

**B. English 4 years required:** English 9, English 10, English 11, English 12

**C. Mathematics 3 years required 4 years recommended:** Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II and higher

**D. Science 2 years required 3 years recommended:**1 Biological lab science,1 Physical lab science

**E. World Languages 2 years required 3 years recommended:** 2 concurrent years of same language

**F. Visual and Performing Arts 1 year required:** Example: Art,Drama, Band, Chorus, and many more Fine Art classes Lawndale offers.

**G. College Prep Elective:** 1 year additional in Mathematics, Science, English, Art, Social Studies, World Language, or AVID Senior Seminar

**Must take the SAT or ACT Exams**

**Total Credits Required for Graduation: 220**



# Two-Year Colleges

- Requires High School Diploma or GED.
- Awards Associate Degrees or certificate of study
- Prepares students to transfer to a 4-year college or university.
- Offers technical training in specific occupations (Computer Tech, Automotive Tech, Construction Tech, Cosmetology, Air Conditioning, Welding, etc)
- Most are non-residential; students live off-campus
- Students can attend part-time or full-time
- Most public 2-year colleges have very low fees
- Cost \$46 a unit



# 4-yr College/University Admission Requirements

Most 4-year colleges require students the following requirements to be considered for admission:

1. Complete the A-G requirements
2. Take the College Entrance Tests (**SAT/ACT**)
3. Earn good grades
4. Demonstrate leadership positions/be a member in clubs/organizations/sports (in school and/or in the community)
5. Complete community service - 100+ hours (~25 per grade)
6. Submit an application, Letter of Rec., personal statement or essay.
